**GENERAL AIM:**

The purpose of the two workshops run with students of the third years of the Social Work degree of the University of Valencia was to show them new tools developed under the project IENE-6 to deal with migrants and refugees' psychological needs as well as their psychological own needs.

**OBJECTIVES:**

1. To show the students new tools to deal with migrants and refugees' psychological needs as well as their psychological own needs
2. To promote the IENE-6 project among the students
3. To provide examples of research projects related to the social work field
4. To show how a European project works to the students of the subject "Social Welfare Policy Research"

**PARTICIPANTS:**

Two workshops were run with students from the group A and C respectively, belonging to the subject "Social Welfare Policy Research" which is part of third year of the Social Work degree in the University of Valencia. In total 63 students attended the two workshops. In the workshop organized with the A group there were 33 attendees and 30 in the workshop run with students from G group.

**CONTENT:**

The workshop covered the following content:

- Introduction to the Erasmus projects
- Introduction to the IENE-6 project:
  - General objective and specific objectives
  - Intellectual outputs
  - Consortium
  - Workplan
- Presentation of the Khub: sections and content

**DURATION:**

The duration of each workshop was 1h and 15 minutes following the timetable provided by the University of Valencia for the sessions.

**EVALUATION:**

A questionnaire with ten questions related to the organization and content of the workshop was administered in order to gather the students' opinion from both groups.

The results presented in Table 1 show that:

- 71.43% of the students strongly agreed with the statement that the goals of the workshop were clear.
- 69.84% of the students strongly agreed with the statement that the agenda was convenient
- 65.05% of the participants strongly agreed that the materials of the workshop were convenient and 85,71% strongly agreed that the workshop was well organized
- 61.90% strongly thought that the place where the workshop was run was convenient

As for the content of the workshop 74.60% of the students strongly agreed with the idea that the goals of the workshop were met and 65.08% of the students strongly thought that the duration and the presentations as well as the discussion generated during the session were convenient. Moreover, 61.90% of the students strongly agreed with the statement that the participation was encouraged during the workshop and 71.43% strongly agreed with the idea that communication was fluent during the workshop.
